

# Frequently Asked Volunteer Questions

**Q: Do you accept volunteer work for court ordered community service?**

**A:** We do not accept community service hours, and currently, do not participate in volunteer to work programs.

**Q: Do you accept volunteers to fulfill hours for high school or college requirements?**

**Q: Is there a minimum age for volunteers?**

**Q: May I bring my kids while I volunteer?**

**A:** We welcome families that want to volunteer. If a child is not a club member, and they want to volunteer with their parent, it should be a project that occurs outside of regular club hours. Otherwise, they must be enrolled as a club member and participate in Club programming while their parent is volunteering.

**Q: Are there a minimum or maximum amount of hours one can volunteer?**

**A:** There are no minimum or maximum requirements for volunteer hours. We are flexible in working with your schedule.

**Q: Where will I be volunteering?**

**A:** We have four Club locations as well as two iStrive outreach sites. Location will be discussed during the interview process. If you have a preference, please indicate on your volunteer application.
